- **Both LCCC ART 2010 & ART 2020 must be completed successfully to be considered equivalent to MCAD AH 1701
- MCAD's BFA program is designed to be completed in 4 years.
- **Submission of a transfer portfolio of studio course work and syllabus is required after admission.**

Please use the guides below when planning your program to transfer to MCAD with an Associate of Arts (AA) from Laramie County Community College. We have indicated the specific courses that meet our foundation curriculum requirements on page 1.

Although MCAD does not participate in the Associate of Arts many of the courses in the AA also fulfill our requirements (see page 3). Our objective is to aid students toward their goal of earning a bachelor degree from MCAD and to provide a smooth transition that minimizes loss of credit and duplication of coursework.

LCCC Art Electives: (credits): Highlighted courses below follow the recommended course sequencing for the AFA.

MCAD Studio Credit Requirements- The LCCC studio art electives in the areas of ART may transfer as studio electives to MCAD (p.1). **A studio transfer portfolio and syllabus is required for transfer review to receive upper level studio requirement credit.** MCAD has maximum allowable studio transfer credits; please contact your Admission Counselor for guidance.
